However, despite its potential as a trust-free and automated system, new challenges emerge with each advancement. Similar to the preceding events, the 3rd ForDigital Blockchain workshop aims to provide an interdisciplinary platform for researchers and innovative practitioners to analyze these challenges, explore solution concepts, and discuss economic implications.
